PG taught us that the 3 keys to revival is Faith, Dominion, and People Skills. Each one contributing to the fruitfulness of a minister, a couple, a congregation. This simple statement & lesson formed a ministry approach early on that very much helped me stay focused to the commission, but also helped me to earn incredible favor with people. It set a course, but over time I have come to recognized the genius of this statement!

In the passage we are going to look at; We see this very idea in Jonathan; he had FIGHT and a Tenderness in relationships... We see the heart of a warrior, and the heart of a friend... This is the heart we need as Shepherds of God. Hearts of FIGHT and Hearts of Compassion.

1 Samuel 20:34 NIV Jonathan got up from the table in <u>fierce anger</u>; on that second day of the feast he did not eat, because he was <u>grieved</u> at his father's shameful treatment of David.

I MINISTRY HATS:

- A- PG said one morning in discipleship; Anything you want to be in life, be a Pastor, because you will do it all!
- 1. There are many "hats" a minister in our fellowship wears...
- 2. As a Pastor you are a preacher, counselor, accountant, lease reviewer, building project manager, custodian...
- a. A wedding planner, a wedding officiator, family counselor, detective, good cop, bad cop, negotiator...
- b. A carpenter, a plumber, an electrician, masonry worker, roofer, mechanic, landscaper...
- c. A husband, a father, a grief counselor, motivational speaker, life coach, friend, reference point, example, a discipler, a teacher, a scholar...
- B- So; in our passage We see Jonathan expressing 2 contrasting responses to the same circumstance-
- 1. V34 Jonathan got up from the table in <u>fierce anger</u>; on that second day of the feast he did not eat, because he was <u>grieved</u> at his father's shameful treatment of David.
 - a. Fierce anger at the situation and Grief over the same situation!
- 2. Anger in righteousness... That his father would do and say things completely out of the character of God.
- 3. But then we read of the grief; The shame of his father, the breakdown of their relationship, the treatment of his friend and future king by the will of God
- 4. Ministry will need you to lead and rally in a militant aggression... FAITH & DOMINION
 - a. And it will require of you a heart tender to the needs of the sheep... PEOPLE SKILLS

II THE PEOPLE BUSINESS

- A- PWM used to say: We are in the people business...
- 1. People are our business, people is who we are involved with everyday in all that we do-
- a. This is why PWM told me: I don't worry about men learning how to preach, Will they learn how to Shepherd?
- i. 2 different functions within the same man... same couple...
- 2. So, since we are in the people business... isn't it in our best interest to learn PEOPLE SKILLS?
- 3. Jesus mastered this, and reveals this in his ministry.
- a. Luke 2:52 Jesus grew in wisdom and in stature and in favor with God and all the people... Both at work
- b. Revelations 5 describes Jesus as a Lion, and as a lamb... he is the embodiment of both (contrasting traits)
- c. Ps85:10 Mercy and truth have met together; Righteousness and peace have kissed... The cross is both!
- d. The psalmist writes in Ps23: your <u>rod</u> and your <u>staff</u>, they comfort me... One defends, one cares for...

III THE BLESSING OF A LARGE HEART:

- A- This kind of heart makes a man... a couple... a great blessing!
- 1. Because you can navigate the complexities of life!
- a. Jonathan's loyalties were so pulled! They were for God and His will, for his father, for David, for the people...
- i. But he could navigate it, and maneuver through it!
- b. This will help in the complexities of ministry, of life, of responsibilities... Its wide and adaptable.
- 2. It can make you effective to a wide range of people-
- a. Not so narrow to people only like you, or those you prefer, or are comfortable & confident with
- i. You will have the ability to connect with and build bridges with many!
- 3. In that People are blessed: David was greatly blessed by Jonathan
- a. 2Sam1:26 How I weep for you, my brother Jonathan! Oh, how much I loved you!
- i. The blessing you can be to people!
- ii P.Aragon... If you'll marry them and bury them they'll love you forever!
- 4. Dominion is established: Jonathan never lost sight of the purpose of his people... establish the KOG-
- a. He fought for Israel, he took the Philistine Garrison, he died fighting for the plans and purposes of God
- i. He remained a warrior!
