## "BIOGRAPHY OF A CALLED MAN"

Biography: Life-story. We read of military/business/politics - To discover how they got there. Paul gives the biography of a called man.

## I. A SERVANT OF JESUS CHRIST

- A. Paul describes the basic/overall posture of his life: VI A servant of Jesus Christ...
  - 1. Servant = slave: One whose life & will is at the disposal of another
    - a. 1 Cor 6:20 for you were bought with a price... I am owned by God!
  - 2. This attitude permeated Paul's salvation
    - a. Constant: every area of life: Time/\$/relationships...
    - b. Ongoing: Not just for a small time; Paul had been saved/in the ministry for years!
  - 3. This is not based on position or reward
    - a. The motivation is not what I'm getting or what position I am in
      - 1. Some disciples: If I was the concert director or preaching in the concert I would do that... but if not, then NO!
    - b. Slaves didn't get anything and were in the lowest position
- B. The heart that God is able to use is a submitted heart
  - 1. His conversion: Acts 9:6 what would have me to do ...?
- a. Samuel: 1 Samuel 3:10 The LORD came and stood there and called as he had before, "Samuel, Samuel!" Samuel said, "Speak, LORD. I am your servant and I am listening."

## II. CALLED TO BE AN APOSTLE

- A. The great issue of discipleship Calling: VI Called to be an apostle...
  - 1. God has plans for your life: Things He has chosen for you to do
    - a. Called: Invitation to a purpose...to summons in order to give a task
  - 2. Things that don't exist yet: Things you might not even choose for yourself see in yourself
    - a. Jer 1:5 Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart; I appointed you as a prophet to the nations.
- B. But he is called to be an apostle: A sent one...
  - 1. Has the idea of being sent often as an ambassador to reach other people
    - a. Specific people you are chosen to reach with the Gospel
      - 1. God planned for Paul to reach Lydia/Timothy/Onesimus
        - a. To save them from hell! Jude 1:23 snatch others from the fire and save them;
        - b. To totally transform their entire lives: Drugs/alcohol/loneliness/violence/suicide no hope!
        - c. To help them fulfill their calling/destiny in God!
          - 1. Mark & Cheryl Underwood: 15,000 miles from Prescott/3,000 miles from Perth... Chosen/planned for us!
      - 2. Who does God have planned for you to reach?
    - b. Specific cities you are chosen to reach with the Gospel
      - 1. Your life making impact in a specific city: One you may have never heard about!
    - c. Specific nations you are chosen to reach with the Gospel
      - 1. An ambassador has the idea of another nation: Paul traveled to the nations/impacted people across borders!
        a. 1 Cor 10:16 To preach the Gospel in regions beyond...

## III. SET APART FOR THE GOSPEL

- A. Calling demands a response: You have to do something in response to the fact that you are called by God
  - 1. If you do nothing about your calling you will go nowhere!
    - a. You aim your entire life at your calling by the decisions you make in life
      - 1. OT prophets: Illustrated sermons; They lived out their calling in obedience to God!
  - 2. You can't live your life the same as someone who is not called!
    - a. V1 separated OT Holy/consecrated: Different than other things because it has a Holy purpose
- B. Our scripture speaks in VI being separated to the Gospel of God...
  - 1. We are separated to a message: Gospel of God is the good news of salvation
    - a. Disciples should aim their lives at evangelism/fruitfulness/soul-winning/follow-up!
  - 2. We are separated to God's word: Ambassadors should have something to say from their ruler
    - a. Our lives should revolve around the word of God
      - 1. Reading/praying over/crying out for wisdom to understand/asking questions/studying/practicing
    - b. So when we get to the people/place God has chosen: We should have something to say from God!
